Pool Use Rules

We thank you for your compliance

- The Pool is open daily from 7am to 7pm; swimming is permitted within these hours only.
- The Management reserves the right to close the swimming pool partially or fully at any time without prior notice to conduct events, pool parties and for periodical cleaning or maintenance.
- > Taking shower before entering the pool is mandatory.
- > Proper swimming costume is a must for using the swimming pool facilities.
- > Any person with hair longer than shoulder length must wear a swimming cap.
- Any individual above the age of 12 must present a double vaccinated certificate to use the pool as CAB.
- Use of the pool will be permitted only in the presence of the Lifeguard on duty.
- > No floating toys are permitted in the pool.
- > Diving is prohibited in the pool.
- > Children may swim in the pool only when supervised by their parents or adult guardians.
- Swimming by members would be at their own risk, the company is indemnified for any accidents that might happen due to the negligence of the member.
- > Persons under the influence of alcohol are not allowed to use the Pool.
- > Chewing tobacco, eating, drinking or smoking etc is prohibited within the pool premises.
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing nose in the pool are prohibited.
- Any member with skin disease or open wound/bandages may not use the pool until he produces a fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- > Members are requested not to bring valuables and jewellery while using the pool.
- Management cannot be held liable for loss of any valuables or other personal property left at the swimming pool premises or any other facility.
- Pool users are requested to maintain decorum at all times. No person within the pool area shall behave in such a manner as to jeopardize the safety and health of himself/herself and others. Such behavior, including usage of abusive language shall be grounds of expulsion.
- The Management, through its pool attendants reserves the right to refuse admission to or require any person to leave the premises.

- Guests violating pool rules especially by jumping into the swimming pool with their clothes on, will be fined Rs 1000 per person
